PARISH HEALING MISSION: June 6th to 10th at St. Joseph Parish, North Sydney given by Fr. Albert MacPherson, OSA, Augustinian Healing Ministry, Chaplain of our Lady of Grace Monastery and Director of our Lady of Grace Shrine. Fr. CHALICE CHILD SPONSORSHIP: Next weekend, Wanda Fedora, a sponsor with Chalice will speak at the Masses. Chalice is Canada's largest Catholic child sponsorship organization. Chalice was founded in 1992 by Fr. Pat Cosgrove, Halifax.

They now support almost 50,000 children and elders in 13 developing countries: Bolivia, Chile, Guatemala, Chana, Haiti, India, Kenya, Ukraine, Paraguay, Peru, Philippines, Tanzania, Zambia. They partner with groups of lay people, religious missionaries and local communities to run their sites.

The sponsor sites work with communities that lack the essentials, including food, medicine and clean water. The sponsorship costs \$ 42.00 per month.

Chalice commits more than 90% of its spending in support of the program. Charitable tax receipts for the full amount of the sponsorship are available.
